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POLICY REGARDING ISSUANCE OF NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) FOR MIGRATION, TRANSFER AND INTERNSHIP OF BAMS STUDENTS

NATIONAL COLLEGE OF AYURVEDA AND HOSPITAL

Preamble

Whereas National College of Ayurveda and Hospital, Barwala, Hisar, Haryana ("the Institution"). is committed to maintaining academic excellence, institutional discipline, regulatory Compliance, quality assurance, educational continuity, and effective patient-care services;

And Whereas continuity of academic programmes, maintenance of sanctioned student strength, institutional development, accreditation objectives. and compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements are integral to the orderly functioning of the Institution;

And Whereas requests for migration, transfer, or transfer of internship may, in certain circumstances, affect academic planning, institutional administration. and programme stability;

Now, therefore. following Policy is hereby adopted to regulate the consideration and disposal of applications seeking issuance of a No Objection Certificate (NOC) for migration, transfer, or internship.

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

- 1.1 This Policy shall be Called the "Policy Regarding Issuance of No Objection Certificate (NOC) for Migration, Transfer and Internship of BAMS Students".
- 1.2 This Policy shall come into force with immediate effect from the date of its approval and notification.

2. OBJECT

Object of this Policy is to;

- a) Promote academic continuity and programme stability;
- b) Ensure compliance with applicable laws and regulations;
- c) Provide a transparent framework for consideration of NOC applications; and
- d) Safeguard the academic and administrative interests of the Institution while ensuring fairness to students.

3. DEFINITION

Unless the context otherwise requires:

- a) "Institution" means National College of Ayurveda and Hospital, Dhani Garan Road, Barwala, Hisar, Haryana.

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- b) "NOC" means No Objection Certificate issued by the Institution.\
- c) "Migration" means movement of a student from this Institution to another institution as permitted under applicable law and regulations.
- d) "Transfer" means transfer of admission or continuation of studies from this Institution to another institution.
- e) "Internship Transfer" means transfer of the mandatory internship, in whole or in part, from the Institution to another institution or hospital.
- f) "Competent Authority" means the Governing Body, Principal, or any officer authorized by the Institution to decide matters under this Policy.

4. APPLICABILITY

- 4.1 This Policy shall apply to all applications, representations, requests, or proceedings relating to migration, transfer, or internship transfer submitted on or after the date of its notification.
- 4.2 This Policy shall be read subject to applicable laws, NCISM Regulations, University Regulations, governmental directions, and judicial orders.

5. GENERAL POLICY

- 5.1 Admission to the Institution shall ordinarily be deemed to be for completion of the entire BAMS programme and mandatory internship within the Institution, subject to applicable regulations.
- 5.2 The Institution shall ordinarily decline requests for issuance of NOC relating to:
 - a) Migration to another Ayurvedic Medical College or Institution;
 - b) Transfer after admission to any Professional BAMS course;
 - c) Transfer during an ongoing academic session or academic year;
 - d) Transfer of internship to another institution or hospital; or
 - e) Continuation of studies in another institution after admission to this Institution.
- 5.3 No student shall claim issuance of an NOC as a matter of right.
- 5.4 Mere submission of an application shall not create any obligation upon the Institution to issue an NOC.
- 5.5 Every application shall be considered on its own facts and in accordance with this Policy, applicable regulations, and institutional requirements.

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6. INSTITUTIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

While deciding an application, the Institution may consider, among other relevant factors:

- a) Academic continuity;
- b) Programme stability and student retention;
- c) Regulatory and statutory compliance;
- d) Accreditation and quality assurance requirements;
- e) Availability of academic and administrative records;
- f) Institutional planning and developmental requirements;
- g) Impact on sanctioned student strength; and
- h) Any other relevant academic or administrative consideration.

7. FAIRNESS AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

- 7.1 All applications shall be considered fairly, objectively, and without discrimination.
- 7.2 Similar cases shall ordinarily be treated alike, subject to differences in facts, applicable law, and regulatory requirements.
- 7.3 No applicant shall derive any advantage solely on account of status, influence, recommendation, or extraneous considerations.

8. NO ENTITLEMENT THROUGH RECOMMENDATION OR INFLUENCE

- 8.1 No recommendation, representation, endorsement, influence, intervention, communication, or support from any public representative, political office-bearer, government official, advocate, organization, parent, guardian, relative, or third party shall create any right or entitlement to issuance of an NOC.
- 8.2 No person shall seek to obtain an NOC through direct or indirect pressure, influence, or extraneous considerations.
- 8.3 The Institution shall remain independent in its decision-making process and shall decide applications strictly in accordance with law and this Policy.

9. REPRESENTATIONS AND LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

- 9.1 Submission of a representation, complaint, grievance, legal notice, appeal, petition, or proceeding before any authority or court shall not, by itself, create an entitlement to issuance of an NOC.
- 9.2 Nothing contained herein shall restrict any statutory or legal remedy available under applicable law.
- 9.3 Pendency of any representation or proceeding shall not, by itself, obligate the Institution to issue an NOC.

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10. EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Policy, the Competent Authority may, in exceptional circumstances and without creating any precedent, consider issuance of an NOC.

A. Serious Medical Grounds

Where:

- The student suffers from a serious medical condition rendering continuation of studies at the Institution substantially impracticable; and
- Relocation is certified as medically necessary.

The application shall be supported by:

- A certificate issued by a Government Medical Board or Civil Surgeon;
- A detailed medical opinion specifically recommending relocation or migration; and Relevant medical records.

Ordinary illnesses, temporary ailments, manageable chronic conditions, lifestyle disorders, or conditions reasonably manageable while pursuing studies shall not ordinarily constitute sufficient grounds.

The Institution may seek verification, re-examination, or an independent medical opinion from a Government Medical Board or competent authority.

B. Death of Parent or Legal Guardian

Where the death of a parent or legal guardian results in compelling circumstances requiring permanent relocation and rendering continuation of studies at the Institution substantially impracticable.

Appropriate documentary evidence shall be mandatory.

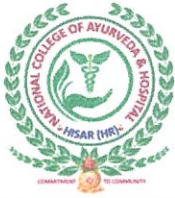
C. Exceptional Matrimonial Circumstances

In the case of a female student, where relocation arising from marriage demonstrably renders continuation of studies at the Institution impracticable.

Such application shall be supported by satisfactory documentary evidence.

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D. Statutory or Judicial Requirement

Where issuance of an NOC becomes necessary pursuant to:

- i. A binding order of a court of competent jurisdiction;
- ii. A direction issued by NCISM, the University, the Central Government, the State Government, or any competent statutory authority; or
- iii. Any mandatory legal requirement having overriding effect over this Policy.

11. NO PRECEDENT

- 11.1 Grant of an NOC in any individual case shall not create any precedent, expectation, equity, or enforceable right in favour of any other student.
- 11.2 Every application shall be decided independently on its own facts and circumstances.

12. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

- 12.1 The Institution reserves the right to decline any application that is inconsistent with applicable law, regulatory requirements, academic continuity, programme stability, or legitimate institutional interests.
- 12.2 The Institution shall retain discretion to evaluate and decide every application in accordance with this Policy and applicable law.

13. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

- 13.1 Nothing contained in this Policy shall override, curtail, or derogate from any applicable law, regulation, university statute, ordinance, governmental notification, or judicial order.
- 13.2 In the event of any inconsistency, the applicable law or binding direction shall prevail to the extent of such inconsistency.

14. FINAL AUTHORITY

- 14.1 Subject to applicable law, the Competent Authority shall be the final authority for deciding applications relating to migration, transfer, internship transfer, and issuance of NOCs.
- 14.2 Interpretation of this Policy shall vest in the Competent Authority.

15. IMPLEMENTATION

- 15.1 A copy of this Policy shall be displayed on the Institutional Notice Board and official website.
- 15.2 The Institution may obtain declarations, acknowledgements, or undertakings from students and their parents or guardians for implementation of this Policy.

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- 15.3 This Policy shall form part of the institutional framework governing admissions, academic administration, and student conduct.

16. DISPUTE RESOLUTION AND JURISDICTION

- 16.1 Any grievance arising under this Policy shall first be submitted to the Governing Body for consideration and resolution.
- 16.2 The parties shall endeavour to resolve disputes amicably through consultation and institutional mechanisms before resorting to legal proceedings.
- 16.3 Subject to applicable law, the courts having territorial jurisdiction at Barwala, Hisar, Haryana, shall have exclusive jurisdiction in matters arising out of or relating to this Policy.
